Dr. James M. Renihan will teach 4 Friday night classes on "Highlights From Baptist History".

Dr. James M. Renihan—born and raised in Massachusetts, Jim graduated from Liberty University, Trinity Ministerial Academy, Baptist Seminary of the east and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. His doctoral thesis from Trinity has been recently published under the title, *Edification and Beauty (The Practical Ecclesiology of the 17th Century Particular Baptists)*. Jim is currently Dean and Professor of Historical Theology at the Institute for Reformed Baptist Studies at Westminster Seminary California, Escondido, California. Ordained to the gospel ministry in 1984, Jim has served as a Baptist pastor in Massachusetts and New York besides his current role as one of the pastors at the Christ Reformed Baptist Church. His other publications include the editing of *True Confessions (Baptist Documents in the Reformed Family)*, joint editing of the *Covenant Theology From Adam To Christ (Nehemiah Cox & John Owen on the Covenants)*; and the Introduction to Benjamin Beddome's *A Scriptural Exposition of the Baptist Catechism*, along with numerous shorter works and articles for scholarly journals. Jim is a leading authority on the history and theology of the 1689 Baptist Confession and is currently working on a scholarly exposition of it. He is one of the editors of The Reformed Baptist Theological Review. Jim and his wife, Lynne, were married in 1978. They have five children and a growing number of grandchildren. They reside in Escondido, California.
